Hence it was resolved that the Principal be requested to make necessary budget allocation from the same.

3. Procurement of Smart Boards and ailied facilities for ICT based Teaching-Learning: enhancement of teaching-learning through the introduction of the ICT enabled mechanism was felt as necessary. To this end, it was resolved that the college provides at least one smart board per department. Further, it was also resolved that all the departments work towards developing PPT based course modules, video lectures, and collect e-books to enrich teaching and learning.

Principal informed the House that a commerce lab with a tally facility and books is being established, language lab is being refurbished, generators are ordered and assured that each department would get a smart board with accessories under the RUSA assistance first phase. The IQAC appreciated the steps taken by the college administration.

Introduction / Formalisation of Special Lecture Series in Departments. The IQAC felt that the quality of teaching learning could be enhanced with special lectures from eminent personalities. It recognized the efforts make to this effect by different departments. However, it resolved that such special lectures should be introduced in departments where it is not being done, and further resolved that in departments where it is done informally, it resolved to recommend for the formalization of the system so that the continuity and quality could be maintained.

3 Review of the teaching learning through 2015 June to December. The coordinator informed the members of the IQAC that it has received no information on any difficulty whatsoever in the teaching learning and evaluation process in the college during the course of the academic session.
