The coordinator requested the Chair to conduct the meeting and handed over the agenda

- Review of Previous Proposals: The coordinator of the IQAC read out the minutes of the
 previous meeting. The coordinator further informed the house that the system of Special Lecture
 Series was formalized under its Flagship Programme by the Department of Political Science.
 Further, it was found that a three days workshop on Fluman Values was conducted coordinated by
 Dr. Padam Nepal of the Department of Political Science with Rev. Ven. Lungten Gyatsho from
 Bhutan being the Resource Person of the Workshop.
- 2 Promotion of Research: The TOAC felt that the quality of teaching learning depended significantly on the research by the faculty members. Hence, it resolved that for the promotion of research in the college, it would apprise the Principal to procure a work station for the college with necessary accessories, power back-up and software.
- 3. Procurement of Books: The members expressed that with the frequent changes in the syllabus and in view of the likelihood of the affiliating university intending to introduce CBCS system with revised curriculum, there was a need to equip departments with updated reading materials and books. Thus it was resolved that the IQAC shall request the college authorities to allocate sufficient fund for the procurement of books under the RUSA support.
- 4. Teaching Learning and Evaluation: The IQAC felt the necessity of promoting student participation in both teaching learning processes. Hence it resolved to request departments to strengthen the participative processes of teaching learning and evaluation by way of introducing student seminars, group discussions, debates, student power point presentations, etc.

5. Workshop on Human Values: The coordinator thanked the members for their support in conducting a workshop on Universal Human Values and Personal Transformation. The House also thanked the College, the IQAC, and the Resource Person of the Workshop on Human values held during May 12-14, 2016, Rev. Ven Lungten Gyatsho. Director, Institute of Language and Culture Studies, Trongsa, Royal University of Bhutan for his contribution.

6. AOB: Preparation for the NAAC sponsored Seminar to be held during 25 to 27 June 2016 was

discussed and was found completed in terms of logistics and other arrangements.
