#### Resolutions:

- 1. Sports and Informary for the College as per DPR of the RUSA. The IQAC, having been apprised of the fact that the DPR of the RUSA incorporated the setting up of a college informary and has allocated budget for the appraidation of the existing sports facility in the college resolved that given the space constraints and other limitations, the focus should be on apgrading the indoor sports facility. It was further resolved that the busketball court that has been disturbed because of the construction of a new science block, be repaired and maintained as soon as the construction work is completed. It further resolved that a separate space in the platinian jubilee building be allocated for the college infirmary for the convenience of the students, and that a staff marse be appointed to address the printary health requirements of the students.
- Academic Session 2017-2018: The IQAC suggested that since each department is provided with
  a smart board and projector facility, each department should conduct at least a few ICT enabled
  classes. It also suggested the college administration to provide similar facility to some of the self
  financed course departments.
- Various audits: The IQAC coordinator appraised the house that the college administration has
  accepted the proposal for conducting academic, administrative, green and gender audits of the

institution and has been entrusted to some reputed national auditing agency, and that the reports of the same are awaited.

- Module for Communicative English: The Department of English shall be appraised to develop suitable modules to help students to improve their spoken English and make use of the language lab in this regard.
- 5 Strengthening Various Committees: It is resolved that the TCS shall call for a meeting to discuss the plan of action of various committees and to reinvigorate the committees to complete the evaluation of their activities at the end of the year and report on its activities to the IQAC.
- Faculty Development Programs: The IQAC resolves to request the college administration to organize more faculty development programmes over and above the Refresher and orientation Courses conducted by the UGC.
- 7.
